



2021-2022 STANDARDIZED DRESS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH FOURTH GRADE STUDENTS

The dress code is listed in the SCA Student Handbook. SCA administration, teachers, and staff reserve the right to determine appropriate or inappropriate dress during school hours and at official school functions. **Students are to appear conservative, modest, and appropriate.**

GENERAL

- ***Hairstyles, makeup, and accessories should be kept in line with the Student Handbook guidelines.***
- SCA uniforms or spirit wear must not be altered in any way (*e.g., markings or drawings, pins, rips, tears, holes, etc.*).

SHIRTS/SWEATERS

- ***No patterns, insignias, nor brand symbols are permitted.***
- Polo Style shirts may be in any solid color (long or short sleeve).
- Shirts need to be tucked in.
- Oxford-style dress shirt may be worn in any solid color.
- Sweaters must be cardigans or V-neck pullovers in any solid color.
- Peter Pan collar blouses must be a solid color (girls only).

PANTS/SHORTS

- Dockers/uniform style pants or walking shorts must be black, navy, grey, or tan khaki with either pleated or flat front in cotton twill
- No cargo, carpenter, drawstring waists, hip huggers, joggers, jeggings, skinny pants, bell bottoms, denim, corduroy, knit, nor polyester are permitted.
- Pants must be worn at the appropriate waist level.
- Shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length.
- Kindergarten may wear elastic waist pants.

SKIRTS/SKORTS/LEGGINGS - (Girls only)

- Solid skirts/skorts may be worn in black, navy, grey, or tan khaki.
- Skirts and skorts may be no shorter than 2 inches from the top of the knee.
- Any coordinating solid color leggings may be worn under skirts.

JUMPERS/POLO DRESSES - (Girls only)

- Solid jumper may be worn in black, navy, grey, or khaki.
- Solid polo dress may be in any solid color.
- Jumpers and polo dresses may be no shorter than 2 inches from the top of the knee.
- Solid colored shorts must be worn underneath jumpers and polo dresses.

BELTS

- Belts are highly encouraged for grades 1- 4.
- Belts must be black or brown.

SWEATSHIRTS/HOODIES

- Summit sweatshirts/hoodies may be worn over uniform dress or spirit wear.
- Only Summit jackets/sweatshirts/hoodies may be worn in class.
- Zip up Summit hoodies must have a uniform shirt underneath.

SHOES

- Tennis shoes are recommended and must be fastened, laced, and tied during the school day.
- Boots, casual, and dress shoes are permitted.
- All shoes must have a closed-back, covered toe, clean, and in good condition.
- No flip-flops, "Crocs" style, roller skate shoes, mules, house slippers, nor "light up" shoes are permitted.

SPIRIT DAY ATTIRE

- The last day of each week is Spirit Day. School administration may announce other days as Spirit Days throughout the year.
- Students may wear Summit branded t-shirts/sweatshirts/hoodies with (blue only) jeans and jean shorts or uniform bottoms.
- No overalls or jeggings are permitted.
- No markings, drawings, pins, rips, tears, holes, etc., permitted.
- Students not participating in Spirit Days need to be in full school uniform.

AFTER SCHOOL ATTIRE

- School uniform standards of modesty, tightness, and shortness apply to attire worn at after school functions.



2021-2022 STANDARDIZED DRESS FIFTH THROUGH TWELFTH GRADE STUDENTS

The dress code is listed in the SCA Student Handbook. SCA administration, teachers, and staff reserve the right to determine appropriate or inappropriate dress during school hours and at official school functions. **Students are to appear conservative, modest, and appropriate.**

SHIRTS/SWEATERS

- **No patterns, insignias, nor brand symbols are permitted.**
- Polo Style shirts may be in any solid color (long or short sleeve).
- Oxford-style dress shirt may be worn in any solid color.
- Sweaters must be cardigans or V-neck pullovers in any solid color.

PANTS/SHORTS

- Dockers/uniform style pants or walking shorts must be black, navy, grey, or tan khaki with either pleated or flat front.
- No cargo, carpenter, hip huggers, joggers, jeggings, skinny pants, bell bottoms, denim, corduroy, knit, nor polyester are permitted.
- Pants and shorts must be worn at the appropriate waist level.
- Shorts –may be no shorter than fingertip length.

SKIRTS/LEGGINGS-(Girls only)

- Solid skirts may be worn in black, navy, grey, or tan khaki.
- Skirts may be no shorter than 2 inches from the top of the knee.
- Any coordinating solid color leggings may be worn under skirts.

SWEATSHIRTS/HOODIES

- Summit sweatshirts/hoodies may be worn over uniform dress or spirit wear.
- Only Summit sweatshirts/hoodies may be worn in class.
- Zip-up Summit hoodies must have a uniform shirt underneath.

SHOES

- Tennis Shoes, boots, casual, dress shoes, and Birkenstock-style sandals are permitted. Heels worn must not exceed 2".
- No flip-flops, "Crocs," roller skate shoes, mules, nor house slippers are permitted.

SPIRIT DAY ATTIRE

- The last day of each week is Spirit Day. School administration may announce other days as Spirit Days throughout the year.
- Students may wear Summit branded t-shirts/sweatshirts/hoodies with (blue only) jeans and jean shorts or uniform bottoms.
- No overalls or jeggings permitted.
- No markings, drawings, pins, rips, tears, holes, etc., permitted.
- Students not participating in Spirit Days need to be in full school uniform.

AFTER SCHOOL ATTIRE

- School uniform standards of modesty, tightness, and shortness apply to attire worn at after school functions.

OTHER

- Students must remain in standardized dress for the entire school day. If a student leaves campus and returns to school for an organized activity/practice, he/she must return in standardized dress code.
- Clothing should fit the student and not be excessively baggy or form fitting.
- ***Hairstyles, makeup, and accessories should be kept in line with the Student Handbook guidelines.***
- SCA uniforms or spirit wear must not be altered in any way. (e.g., markings or drawings, pins, rips, tears, holes, etc.)
