Senior Parking Spot Painting 2021-2022

Summit Christian Academy is allowing senior students to paint their own parking spot in a designated area for the upcoming school year. This is an opportunity to show your school pride and senior pride with quality artwork. Please thoroughly read the entire packet if you wish to paint a parking spot.

SENIOR SUNRISE will take place on August 9th at 6:00am at the Summit high school. We will watch the sunrise then proceed to paint parking spaces. Students that decide to not paint a parking space are encouraged to still attend the sunrise. *If you are painting, please wear clothes that can get paint on them to the senior sunrise.

COST:

To receive a senior parking spot for painting you must bring \$30 to the senior sunrise on August 9th. You will not be allowed to paint if you do not bring \$30. Funds raised will be given to Student Council for future events.

DESIGN CRITERIA:

Email Mr. White <u>kwhite@summit.school</u> a *color* picture of your design by August 4th to be approved. This can be a picture online that you are going to copy or a drawing. The design must be done in color and must represent exactly what will be painted on your parking space.

The following will be prohibited for the designs:

- No offensive language, pictures, or symbols
- No negative or rude language
- No inappropriate content
- The reserving student's name is the ONLY name/ initials that will be allowed to be painted on the spot

*If you paint any prohibited items or your parking space does not match the design you had approved, your space will be painted over, you may face disciplinary actions, and you may forfeit your parking space with no refund.

QUALITY:

This is an opportunity to make artwork, show your Summit pride, and make a good representation of the school. If you are lacking the artistic abilities to make your parking space look nice, bring in family, friends, or preferably an artistic student that is not a senior to help. You will be required to leave 4 inches between the parking space lines and the artwork. You will use a measuring tape and painter's tape for this.

*If you paint your design in a sloppy, careless manner, your space may be painted over in black.

MATERIALS:

*required

- *WATER-BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint
- *Exterior Kilz primer
- *Brushes, rollers, sponges to paint with
- *Masking tape or painter's tape
- *Measuring tape
- *Plastic cloth or trash bags for under paint cans
- Chalk to sketch
- Broom to sweep the spot
- Stool, towel, or lawn chair to sit on
- Plastic container/tray for water and brushes
- Water bottle
- o Sunscreen
- Copy of approved design to use as a template

DO NOT purchase paint that is oil based, spray paint, reflective paint, neon paint, indoor paint, or raised paint. All paint will be approved on day of painting. *If your paint is not the correct type (Water based, latex, exterior paint) you will not be allowed to paint.

You will need to purchase a gallon of paint for your background color or larger area and quarts of paint for details or smaller areas.

PAINTING DAY:

Step 1: Attend senior sunrise

Step 2: After sunrise check in with Grace or Emma to pay \$30 and receive your parking space

Step 3: Get your paint approved by Evan or Mrs. Burnett

Step 4: Sweep any debris off your space with a broom

Step 5: Measure 4 inches from the white parking line and tape the perimeters

Step 6: Paint on the primer

Step 7: Paint your approved design and HAVE FUN!

I hereby agree to abide by all the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- I will only use approved paint on my parking space.
- I will only paint within the designated boundaries (leave 4 inches between parking lines and artwork).
- I will not paint using oil based, spray paint, reflective paint, neon paint, indoor paint, or raised paint.
- I will only paint the space that is designated to me.
- I will bring the supplies needed to paint.
- I will never park in another space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space during the school year.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I will complete my painting during the designated painting day (August 9th)
- unless informed of an alternate date.
- If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realizes my painting rights will be forfeited. If I paint anything unapproved in my spot, I will also forfeit my parking space without refund, and my spot will be painted over.
