What does my student need to do?

READ!!! After reading a book, students need to take the Reading Counts quiz. Quiz attempts are limited to 4 per day. All quizzes must be completed by Wednesday, March 8th at 3pm.

What is the reading goal?

The class goal for each 4th grade class is 800 points. Each student needs to work hard towards attaining that goal.

What are the class prizes?

If your student's class earns 350 points, they will watch a movie on the afternoon of March 9th. If the class earns 450 points, they will have popcorn while watching the movie. If the class earns 600 points, they can have pop during the party. And if the class earns 800 points, they will add some cookies to go along with all their other goodies.

Remember, to participate in the party each student must earn 16 points.

Every student who earns 100 points or more will be added to the Reading Superhero Wall of Fame and earn a special trip to the park The student who earns the most points in each grade will be treated to lunch with Dr. Kelly and Mrs. Bradley.
