What does my student need to do?

READ!!! After reading a book, record the title of the book in the Reading Log. After reading 40 books, students turn in the Reading Log for a prize and a new Reading Log. All Reading Logs are due Wednesday, March 8th by 3pm.

Students can read the book independently or have the book read to them.

What is the reading goal?

The class goal for each kindergarten class is 500 books. Each student needs to work hard towards attaining that goal.

What are the class prizes?

If your student's class reads 200 books, they will watch a movie on the afternoon of March 9th. If the class reads 300 books, they will have popcorn while watching the movie. If the class reads 400 books, they can have juice drinks during the party. And if the class reads 500 books, they will add some cookies to go along with all their other goodies.

Remember, to participate in the party each student must read 40 books.

How can my student become a Reading Superhero?

Every student who turns in 3 or more completed reading logs will be added to the Reading Superhero Wall of Fame and earn a special trip to the park The student who reads the most in each grade will be treated to lunch with Dr. Kelly and Mrs. Bradley.
