

## What does my student need to do?

READ!!! After finishing each book, parents should log the title in the Reading Log. (The reading log must be completed by an adult.) After reading 40 books, students turn in the log for a prize and a fresh new log to keep going. All logs must be submitted by Wednesday, March 12<sup>th</sup> by 9am.

Students can read the book independently or have the book read to them.

## What is the reading goal?

The class goal for each 1<sup>st</sup> grade class is 1,000 books. Every student's mission is to contribute to this goal by reading as much as they can!

## What are the class prizes?

1-Up	Read 200 books to earn a movie on the afternoon of March 13 <sup>th</sup> .
Power Up	Read 400 books, and the movie comes with popcorn!
Boss Level	Read 600 books to enjoy juice drinks during the movie party.
End Game	Reach the ultimate goal of 1,000 books to celebrate with cookies.

Reminder: To take part in the party each student must read at least 40 books.

Every student who completes 4 or more reading logs will earn a special reward: a trip to the park! The top reader from each grade will be treated to a High Score lunch with Dr. Kelly and Mrs. Bradley.
