Key Dates & First-Day Information

Tuesday, August 11 - Meet the Teacher

- **Two come-and-go sessions:** 2:00-3:30 p.m. and 5:00-6:30 p.m.
- **Intermediate Parent Meetings:** In the Rose District Auditorium during the first 20 minutes of each Meet the Teacher session.
- **High School Back-to-School Bash:** 6:30-8:30 p.m. at the South Campus. Students should bring a towel, a plastic bag for wet clothes, flip-flops, and a change of clothes.

Thursday, August 13 - First Day of School

- **Elementary and Intermediate (Pre-K-8):** 8:15 a.m.-3:15 p.m., Rose District Campus. Rose Campus doors open at 7:45 a.m. on the first day.
- **High School (9-12):** 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m., South Campus. Doors open at 8:00 a.m.
- **Early Learning Center and Elementary:** Parents are invited to walk their children to class on the first day.
- **Intermediate and High School:** Students should follow the regular drop-off plan.
- **Upper Elementary families (grades 2-4):** Please park in the public parking area next to the Methodist Church so our youngest Eagle families may park closer to the building.

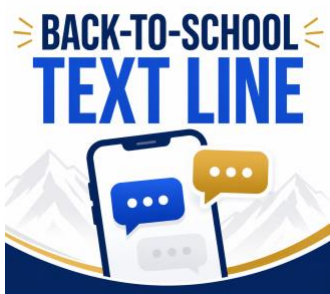

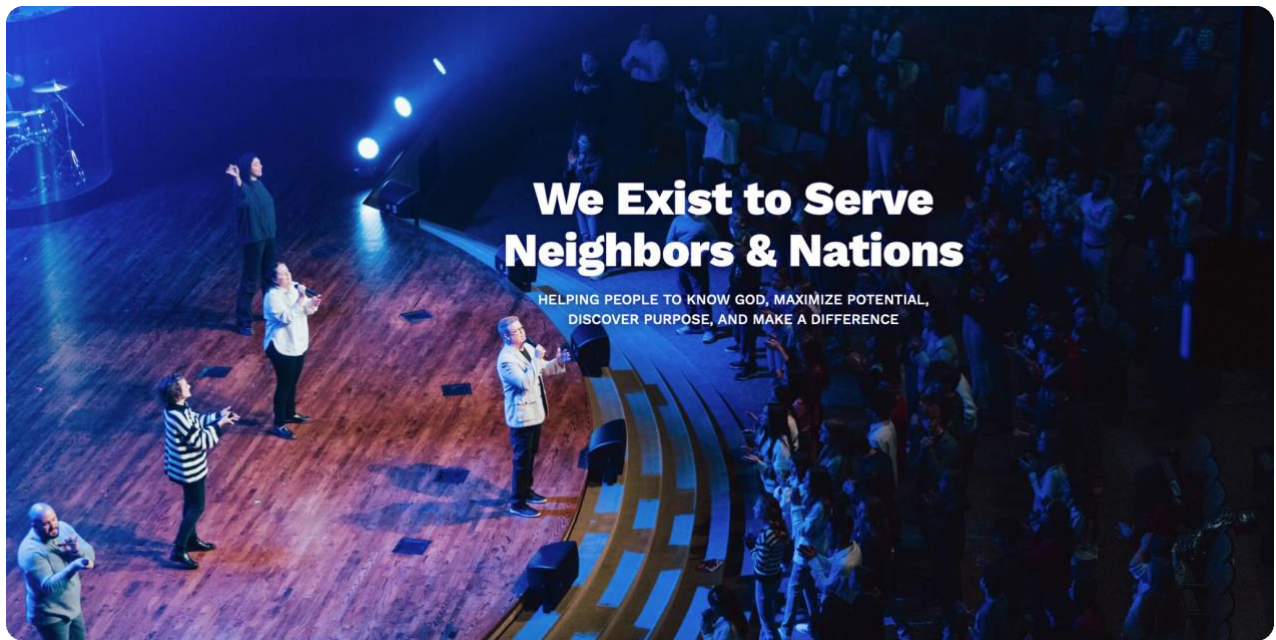
